Committee on Herbal Medicinal Products (HMPC)

Report of the 36th HMPC meeting, held 14-15 July 2010

The Committee welcomed a new observer from Montenegro.

Appointment of Rapporteurs

The HMPC added Uncariae cortex to the HMPC inventory and HMPC priority list and appointed a Rapporteur for the preparation of a monograph/list entry.

Legal interpretation of the provisions regarding indications appropriate to traditional herbal medicinal products

The HMPC welcomed the legal interpretation received from the European Commission concerning the provisions of Article 16a(1)(a) of Directive 2004/24/EC, regarding the possibility for the indications of traditional herbal medicinal products to refer to a prior medical diagnosis with a view to excluding serious conditions, thus ensuring that patients safely self-medicate. Such medical diagnosis can be remote in time from the decision to take a traditional herbal medicine. Community herbal monographs with indications relating to traditional use may refer to a prior medical diagnosis intended to prevent treatment of more serious pathologies with traditional herbal medicinal products. In any case, the traditional herbal medicinal product still needs to be intended and designed for use without the supervision of a medical practitioner for diagnostic purposes or for prescription or monitoring of treatment. The traditional herbal medicinal product has to be a non-prescription medicine.

Cooperation with EFSA

The HMPC heard a report about a meeting held in June 2010 between representatives from the European Food Safety Authority, the European Medicines Agency and the European Commission organised in view of the process of adoption by the Commission of opinions on health claims for food presented by EFSA. The meeting was convened further to the duty for both agencies to identify any potential source of conflicts between their scientific opinions. Areas of overlap were discussed, taking into account the respective legal requirements (Regulation (EC) No 1924/2006 and Directive 2001/83/EC), assessment methodology (e.g. evaluation of clinical efficacy data for substantiation of health claims for botanicals versus benefit-risk assessment for the safe use in specified conditions for traditional herbal medicinal products) and the different purpose of food/food supplements with health claims and herbal medicinal products (e.g. regarding target population and duration of use). It was concluded that no divergence in opinions are present to date. A joint explanatory paper has been transmitted to the European Commission.

Revision of 'Rules for classification of and access to HMPC documents'

The HMPC was informed of new recommendations from the Agency's Legal Service as regards the access to the name of HMPC members who have expressed a divergent position to a HMPC opinion. In view of recent case-law related to the interpretation of the provisions of Regulation 1049/2001, the Legal Service has advised that 'the release of the identity of HMPC members expressing divergent opinions is therefore in principle acceptable; it should not be considered covered by the exception of article 4(3) paragraph 2 of Regulation 1049/2001 unless in exceptional and duly motivated circumstances it can be demonstrated that the identity of the HMPC members should be protected for concrete and specific reasons, further to a case-by-case assessment either to protect the security of individuals (e.g. if scientific experts are exposed to a concrete and significant external threat) or to meet a functional need of the Agency (e.g. involvement of experts in the framework of international collaboration with regulatory authorities)'.

Prioritisation of future assessment works

The deadline for interested parties to comment on the priority level of pending assessment works is extended to **30 September 2010**. Please see the May HMPC meeting report for details.

Report from the Working Party on Community Monographs and Community List (MLWP)

The MLWP held its 27th meeting at the European Medicines Agency on 12-14 July 2010.

In addition to the work that supported the adoption by the HMPC of the above-mentioned draft and final monographs/list entries and related documents, the MLWP made significant progress on the scientific work relating to the assessment of Agni casti fructus (monograph), Cimicifugae rhizoma (monograph), Euphrasiae herba (public statement) and Thymi aetheroleum (list entry). The working party progressed draft monographs on Cynarae folium, Millefolii herba and Oenotherae biennis oleum. The MLWP further discussed a draft monograph on Symphyti radix and reviewed in parallel meetings of 4 small groups draft monographs on Lavandulae aetheroleum, Chelidonii herba, Cichorii intybi radix, Filipendulae ulmariae herba, Millefolii flos, Myrrha, Plantaginis lanceolatae folium and Thymi herba/Primulae radix.

The HMPC heard a report on the work carried out during the ORGAM DG meeting on 16 June 2010.

Quality Drafting Group (Q DG)

The HMPC heard a report on the work carried out during the Q DG meeting on 15 June 2010.

The Q DG progressed with the revision of the Question & Answers on quality matters for herbal medicinal products for publication on EMA website (EMA/HMPC/41500/2010). Previously published Questions & Answers will be merged into one document and further extended. Publication is expected after the September HMPC meeting.

Beside tasks in coordination with the Scientific Advice Working Party, progress was made in particular with finalising the 'Reflection paper on level of purification of extracts to be considered as herbal preparations'.

The next meeting of the Q DG is scheduled for 29 July 2010.
