Achievements:

- Jun 2021: DARWIN EU tender launched (to select a coordination centre)
- Jul 2021: DARWIN EU [Advisory Board](#) established (incl. key stakeholder representatives)
- Nov/Dec 2021: on target for appointment of Coordination centre (CC) in early 2022

Future highlights:

- DARWIN EU Coordination centre appointed (early 2022)
- Start conducting studies for decision making
- DARWIN EU pilot with EHDS
- Report on first year of operation
- EU regulatory network routine access to RWE (training, processes, catalogues of studies and data sources)
